By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 71 dated 28.04.2013, registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is husband of deceased Sushma Rani. The deceased has committed suicide as the messages exchanged between her and her paramour Sukhvir Singh @ Sukhi were read by the petitioner. No incriminating evidence was collected by the investigating agency against the petitioner. In pursuance of the order dated 15.12.2014, the petitioner has appeared and furnished bail/surety bonds before the trial Court.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the order dated 15.12.2014, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
