Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C, seek quashing of criminal complaint No. 7 dated 18.7.2011 titled as Sushma Rani Vs. Kaushalya Devi and others, under Sections 452/323/324/427/506/34 IPC pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Hoshiarpur as well as impugned summoning order dated 6.8.2013 (Annexure P-2).
