LISA GILL, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 67 dated 24.04.2013 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and the complainant has received the entire sum of ₹ 3,50,000/-. The petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to order of this Court.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable Pargat Singh, submits that the petitioner has indeed joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation. There are no allegations on behalf of the State that petitioner is likely to abscond or that he is likely to dissuade the witnesses from deposing true facts in the Court, if released on bail. There is no other case registered against the petitioner.

In view of the above but without expressing any opinion
on the merits of the case, order dated 03.12.2014 is made absolute.

The present petition is, accordingly, allowed.
