Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of FIR No.541 dated 04.10.2013 (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply by way of affidavit dated 05.02.2015 had been filed.

Learned counsel for the State, while referring to para 1 of the affidavit at page 55 of the paper book, submits that since the cancellation report has been prepared in the present case on 29.01.2015 and the same shall be presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction, if not already presented, present petition does not survive and may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the State, present petition does not survive. It is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar-

respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and to ensure that cancellation report, already prepared on 29.01.2015, is presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction, without any further loss of time.
