This petition is under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for giving directions to meet ends of justice by ordering the investigation as to how petitioners have been thrown out of their own house and are not being allowed to enter their house status quo order for the same has already been issued by the local civil Court. This all is being engineering with active help connivance of SI Satnam Singh presently performing the duties of SHO, Police Station Sunam.

On notice, reply has been filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police dated 17.04.2014 taking the preliminary submissions that the petitioner has approached this Court by concealing the material facts and an FIR No.165 dated 11.09.2013 under Section 6 of Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006 and 120-B IPC, P.S. City Sunam was registered against the petitioners and other co-accused on the basis of a statement

made by one Asha Rani wife of late Surinder Kumar. During investigation, Karam Singh, Charna Singh and Sukhwinder Kaur were arrested on 02.10.2013, Virpal Kaur and Prem Lata on 18.10.2013, Baljinder Singh on 21.10.2013 and Balwinder Singh was arrested on 29.10.2013 and challan has been presented and the trial is fixed for 14.03.2015 as informed by ASI Kuldeep Singh.

An application was made to the SSP with regard to the allegations in the present petition, which was received on 14.11.2013 and Asha Rani also moved another application to the Chairman, Punjab State Human Rights Commission, Chandigarh and an information was received by SSP Sangrur on 12.11.2013. Necessary inquiry was conducted and the allegations were found to be false. The SSP Sangrur accepted the inquiry report (R-1 and R-2).

In view of the written statement, no further orders are required to be passed.
