Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 31 dated 11.02.2013, under Sections 307, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 03.12.2014, a Coordinate Bench of this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer

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in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from Head Constable Dharampal, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 03.12.2014 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
