HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, respondents No.4 to 6 are not accepting their marriage and are

adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they had moved a representation dated 27.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Patiala.

Pursuant to the order dated 4.12.2015, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced a photocopy of FDR of Rs.1,00,000/- in name of petitioner No.1 for a period of one year, which is taken on record.

Vakalatnama filed on behalf of respondent No.4 in Court today, is taken on record.

Heard.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners and without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 27.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to get the FDR converted for a period of three years, as directed by this Court vide order dated 4.12.2015, and to place on record a copy of the same with the Registry. It is made clear that in case the said FDR is not converted for a period of three years within two weeks, the present petition would be liable to be dismissed.

At this stage, on the oral request of learned counsel for the petitioners, Registry is directed to call for SHO, Police Station, Sector-3, Chandigarh to provide adequate security to the petitioners for their safe passage/exit from the High Court premises upto place of their residence in District Patiala.
