By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.66, dated 20.09.2015, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and Section 326 IPC was added later on, at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 05.12.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the

investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 05.12.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
