The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.), in complaint case No.309-1 of 14.05.2011 (Comp. No.788/2013) registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506, 420, 354, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Fazilka.

The learned counsel contends that there are no specific allegations with regard to harassment and demand of dowry. Vide order dated 03.12.2014, the petitioners were directed to appear before the trial Court and furnish bail bonds/surety bonds. The learned

counsel states that the order is complied with. The petitioners also undertake to surrender their passports.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, order dated 03.12.2014, is made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
