JASPAL SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Code') preferred by Sohan Singh and others seeking directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the lives and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 7 with further prayer that investigation of the case bearing FIR No. 203, dated September 19, 2014, under Sections 302/34 IPC, at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar be got conducted from some independent agency like CBI or from the vigilance bureau/ crime branch.

2. In response to the notice of motion, Deputy Advocate

General, Punjab appeared and represented State/official respondents.

3. In compliance of order dated July 07, 2015, status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Varinder Paul Singh, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Rupnagar was filed. Perusal of the same, reveals that investigation of this case was carried out by Special Investigation Team (for short, 'SIT'), which came to the conclusion that deceased- Harjit Kaur @ Lehmber Kaur had died due to drowning and private respondents were found innocent and recommended for cancellation of the FIR. Report of SIT was thoroughly scrutinized by SSP, Rupnagar and while agreeing with the same, he issued directions to SHO Police Station Morinda to take necessary action.

3. In view of the status report submitted on behalf of official respondents-State, no further action is called for. Same is accordingly disposed of.
