HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Petitioner has filed the present petition for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to conduct fresh and fair investigation in FIR No.131 dated 16.6.2000 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 447, 511, 506, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, at Police Station Bilaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the entire police file and record, available with the investigating officer has gone missing and he has moved an application under the Right to Information Act, 2005 to provide him the complete copy of FIR No.131 dated 16.6.2000, registered under Sections 447, 511, 506, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, at Police Station Bilaspur, registered by R.K. Kaushik on behalf

of Trillenium Technologies Ltd. against Damanjit Singh grewal son of Charanjit Grewal, as well as status of the FIR.

Vide communication dated 11.11.2014, the Deputy Commissioner of Police has forwarded the requisite information sought under the Right to Information Act, 2005. As per the communication dated 8.11.2014 sent by the Police Station Manesar, the police has prepared the cancellation report in FIR No.131 dated 16.6.2000 (wrongly mentioned as 16.6.2002), under Sections 447, 511, 506, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Bilaspur on 17.7.2002 and the concerned Court has accepted the cancellation report.

Thus, the cancellation report was prepared on 17.7.2002 whereas the present petition has been filed in the year 2015. The petitioner has not pursued the remedies available under law against the cancellation report, prepared by the police and accepted by the Court thereafter. Therefore, the present petition is without any merits and the same is, hereby, dismissed.
