AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record an extract of her Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 29.01.1997 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record an extract of his Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 08.12.1995. They have also moved a

representation jointly addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala and SHO, Police Station Wadala Kalan, Kapurthala (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

The maternal uncle and aunt of petitioner No.1 namely Dalbir Singh and Davinder Kaur have appeared through Sh.Sarvesh Kumar Gupta, Advocate and have sought permission of the Court to meet her stating that parents of the girl are admitted in the hospital. Maternal uncle of the girl has met her in my chamber. She is, however, not ready to go to her parents.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
