Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.116 dated 03.10.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Ludhiana.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner

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has already returned major articles and golden articles which are alleged in the FIR are not with the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant contends that golden articles are yet to be recovered.

There are serious allegations of maltreating the complainant and entrustment of dowry articles, as mentioned in the list, against the petitioner who happens to be husband of the complainant. Otherwise also, attempt was also made to effect compromise, but mediation failed. In view of allegations levelled against the petitioner, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.

Interim relief granted to the petitioner stands vacated.
