NAVITA SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been moved by the petitioner under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 94 dated 04.11.2014, under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code of Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

Complainant-Baljinder Kaur is present in Court in compliance with the order passed on the last date and she has categorically stated that she does not want to live with the petitioner. The stand of the petitioner since beginning is that he wants to rehabilitate the wife.

Counsel for the complainant as also the State counsel submit that recovery of gold and silver ornaments is to be made and it was only for getting interim relief that the petitioner had stated on 04.12.2014 that he wanted to live with the complainant. However, mediation had also failed.

Since recovery of the ornaments is to be made and there is every possibility that the petitioner is insisting on keeping his wife merely for getting relief from this Court, it is felt that grant of anticipatory bail at this stage would not be in the interest of justice.

Dismissed.
