Prayer in the petition is for issuing directions to respondents No.1 and 4 to transfer the investigation to some other District or some independent agency or crime branch by withdrawing the same from respondent No.5, in case FIR No.202 dated 1.11.2015, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Kotakpura, District Faridkot (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to

learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Admittedly, the FIR was registered on 1.11.2015 and any direction to the police at this stage, would tantamount interference in the investigation. Therefore, no ground to interfere in the investigation at this stage is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
