Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4.

Pusuant to the order dated 05.12.2015 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitoners has produced a photocopy of FDR, for an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- in favour of petitioner No.2-Sandeep Kaur. The said photocopy of the FDR is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.4 submits that he has not caused any harm or threat to the petitioners and they will settle

the matter amicably.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Shailender Singh has already stated that the both the petitioners have made statement wherein it was stated that they do not have any threat from the other side.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of, however, in case the petitioners feels that there is any threat to their life and liberty, they shall be at liberty to approach concerned SHO, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
