During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has circulated the marriage certificate. The same is read over by Sh. Syed Kashif Raza which pertains to the petitioner. He, however pointed out that the amount of Mehar in the marriage certificate is reflected as Rs. 10,50,786/- whereas it is Rs. 1,50,786/-. The same appears to be a clerical mistake.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and there is no legal impediment to their marriage. They have solemnized marriage. Their marriage is opposed by respondents Nos.4 & 5.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to take necessary action on the representation dated 03.12.2015 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioners and provide necessary protection to the petitioners, if he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.4 & 5, in accordance with law.
