Report dated 17.1.2015 sent by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Gurbinder Singh and Malkiat Singh as well as of complainant Krishna Devi it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that being a pure civil dispute over money which is not heinous in nature together with the fact that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.10 dated 06.02.2014 under Sections 406,420 IPC Police Station, Amlloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
