Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.177 dated 27.07.2010, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 326, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Line Batala, District Gurdaspur at the instance of respondent No. 2 alleging that the petitioners as members of unlawful assembly had assaulted the complainant and respondent No. 3.

The FIR has been sought to be quashed on the basis of compromised between the parties. Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded. Report has been received that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat or pressure.

In view of the report received, I am of the considered opinion that there are no chance of conviction. This petition is allowed following the judgment in *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052*. The aforesaid FIR and all other criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed on the basis of compromise subject to petitioners depositing a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority within a period of one month.
