This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation of case FIR No.148 dated 10.10.2015 under Sections 304-A and 379 IPC at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural, to some senior police officer as the petitioner is not expecting any fair and impartial investigation from the Investigating Officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the basis of statement of husband of the petitioner, the aforesaid FIR was registered, wherein, the name of respondent No.5 was mentioned specifically by him but subsequently name of one Vineet Kumar has been mentioned in the FIR being the driver of the offending vehicle. The accused-respondent No.5 being influential person has not been involved. He further submits that a detailed

representation dated 15.10.2015(Annexure P-2) has been sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, respondent No.2, but still no action has been taken. He also submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, directions are issued to respondent No.2 to take action on the representation (Annexure P-2), which is still pending.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, respondent No.2, to consider the representation (Annexure P-2) annexed with the petition and take necessary action in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
