JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.24 dated 01.08.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and (Section 326, IPC added later on), registered with Police Station Lakhewali, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, the petitioner/accused-Sohan Singh along with his co-accused father-Surjit Singh @ Mithu entered the field of the complainant-Iqbal Singh and inflicted injuries with *Spade* on account of the complainant having stopped the water channel.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that the petitioner is in custody since 07.09.2015. He further submits that even the alleged injuries have been inflicted by agriculture

implements, allegedly used as weapon. He further submits that co-accused has since been granted regular bail by the learned Sessions Court, Sri Muktsar Sahib. He further submits that the dispute occurred in the spur of moment.

Learned Counsel for the complainant as well as State Counsel have also been heard.

Custody Certificate has also been filed, which is taken on record.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the parity of treatment and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused-Sohan Singh deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.
