Report dated 20.3.2015 sent by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Aayush Gupta, Brij Mohan Gupta and Sunita Gupta as well as of complainant Kanika Gupta it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties having matrimonial dispute compromised the matter and that the compromise will go a long way to settle their life and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.351 dated 06.08.2014 under Sections 66 of Information Technology Act, 2000 Police Station, Sector 5, Panchkula and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
