Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have joined investigation in compliance with interim bail granted by this Court and they are ready to face proceedings in accordance with law.

Counsel for the State of Punjab, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, has conceded to factual assertions and further states that custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim bail granted by this Court on 23.12.2014 is made absolute subject to the

following conditions:-

- i) they shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) they shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and
- (iii) they shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
