JASPAL SINGH, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 20, dated 29.03.2014 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 324, 323 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot, on the basis of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any threat, pressure coercion or undue influence and has been effected between the parties with their freewill and consent. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

So, in view of above circumstances and in view of pronouncement reported as Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another; 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 20, dated 29.03.2014 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 324, 323 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot, is quashed qua the petitioners.
