Petitioner is a complainant in a case under Section 406, 498 A
IPC registered against her husband- respondent.

Through instant petition, the petitioner has sought a direction
for expeditious disposal of the complaint contending that the respondent-
husband being influential person was able to get a cancellation report
presented which was not accepted on the protest of the petitioner and that the
protest petition of the petitioner was treated as a complaint. It has also been
submitted that the examination-in-chief of the petitioner was completed on
April 7, 2012. Despite a period of three years having elapsed, the accused/

respondent has been able to prolong the litigation by adopting delaying tactics.

Next date of hearing before the trial Court is stated to be December 10, 2015.

This petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to the trial Court that in case an application is submitted by the petitioner on December 10, 2015 for expeditious disposal of the case, the matter will be carefully looked into by the trial court to ensure that unnecessary adjournments are not granted to any party to delay the proceedings and the provisions of Section 309 Cr.P.C. are adhered to.
