The present 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.182 dated 03.04.2015, under Sections 324, 326, 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Surajkund, Faridabad (**Annexure P-1**).

As per allegations in the FIR, lodged by the complainant/father-in-law of the petitioner that the petitioner/accused had attacked the daughter-Munni of the complainant (wife of the petitioner) with a *Dao* (a kind of knife) and inflicted seven injuries on the neck and hands of the injured. Three injuries have been opined to be dangerous to life.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2015 and the quarrel had occurred on the spur of the moment in the backdrop of a serious matrimonial dispute between the parties.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from S.I. Vinod Kumar, submits that 07 out of 14 prosecution witnesses have since been examined and the next date is fixed for 18.12.2015 before the trial Court.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is hoped that the prosecution would get the remaining formal witnesses examined at the earliest.
