Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.277 dated 10.11.2014, under Sections 420, 417, 336 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 15(2)(3) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, registered at Police Station Taraori, Distirct Karnal.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 08.12.2014:-

“Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.277 dated 10.11.2014 under Sections 420,417,336 IPC along with Section 15 (2)(3) of the Indian Medical Council Act, Police Station Taraori, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he was unauthorizedly selling Allopathic medicines and the recovery of 25 articles, which include tablets and syrup, has already been effected. He further states that the petitioner is suffering from Cancer and

undergoing treatment from the PGI, Chandigarh. He undertakes to produce on record a Medical Certificate in this regard on the next date of hearing.

Notice of motion for 12.1.2015.

In the meantime, the petitioner is admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall present themselves before the Investigating Officer on 15.12.2014 and abide by all the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Bharam Sarup has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 08.12.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
