Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seek quashing of FIR No.69 dated 04.04.2013 under Section 307 IPC, Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act and Sections 21, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply by way of affidavit dated 10.07.2015 has been filed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), submits that since the cancellation report has already been prepared by the investigating agency, which has also been approved by the Deputy Superintendent of Police on 13.07.2015 and pending for approval of the Senior Superintendent of Police, present petition does not survive and the same may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let the present petition be disposed, in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State but Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) may be directed to ensure early presentation of the cancellation report before the learned Court of competent jurisdiction.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), for whose approval the cancellation report is stated to be pending, to ensure that duly approved cancellation report is presented to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction without any further loss of time and in any case, within a period of three weeks from today.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
