By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.34, dated 22.02.2014, registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar.

The learned counsel refers to Annexure P-3, the photocopy of the passport and states that the petitioner was out of country on the alleged date of occurrence i.e. 10.04.2014. In pursuance of the order dated 12.12.2014, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that

in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 12.12.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
