ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 655 dated 09.08.2014, registered under Sections 346, 302, 201, 34 IPC, Police Station City Jind, District Jind.

A complaint was lodged with the police that Krishan had left home and had not returned. A missing report was lodged. The dead body was recovered later. The police arrested some accused and a disclosure statement was made. Gurmail and Sonu are juveniles facing trial before the Juvenile Justice Board. The petitioner is a cousin of Gurmail. The allegations were that

Krishan deceased was having an affair with the sister of Gurmail and the accused had the motive and it was the petitioner who had murdered Krishan.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that Gurmail and Sonu had been allowed bail and he seeks parity. Counsel further urges that the rod was recovered from Sonu and the petitioner is in custody since August, 2015.

The bail application has been opposed by the State. The State counsel urges that out of 21 witnesses, 12 witnesses had already been examined and petitioner is the main accused and cannot seek parity with Gurmail and there was a motive and he was the person who had inflicted the vital injury and threw the body in the canal.

Considering the seriousness of the allegations, no case for bail is made out. The petition is dismissed.
