Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.377 dated 09.10.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 11.12.2014:-

“Notice of motion for 16.02.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

List along with Crl. Misc. No.M-41011 of 2014.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by

Assistant Sub Inspector Balraj has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 11.12.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
