This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.100 dated 04.10.2014, registered under Sections 323, 498-A, 354, 147, 149 IPC and 406 IPC at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 17.12.2014, directed that in the event of arrest, petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/investigating officer in connection with abovesaid case FIR.

Learned State counsel stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for interrogation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and the complainant state that the parties have also amicably settled the matter.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, the order dated 17.12.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition disposed of accordingly.
