JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.182 dated 11.10.2015 under Section 18 of the NDPS Act, P.S. Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

As per the allegations, the petitioner was apprehended being in possession of 500 grams of Opium.

It is contended that the Chemical Examiner Report is yet to be received and otherwise also the alleged quantity is non-commercial.

The petitioner is in custody for almost two months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State Counsel assisted by HC Zora Singh is unable to refute the above position to oppose the claim for interim bail at this stage, however, subject to the final outcome after receipt of Chemical Examiner report.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to be released presently on interim bail subject to the final outcome after receipt of the report of the Chemical Examiner. The petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
