The present petition has been preferred by Surjanpal Singh-petitioner, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case bearing FIR No. 437, dated 29.11.2014, under Sections 423, 406, 498-A/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran.

It is an undisputed fact that petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order passed by this Court on February 09, 2015.

On instructions from HC Manjit Singh, it has been

submitted by learned State counsel that recovery of articles has already been effected. Moreover, it is a debatable question whether the allegations levelled by the complainant are true in view of the inquiry report (Annexure P-3).

Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and considering the above referred facts, order dated February 09, 2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
