Pursuant to order dated 04.03.2015 passed by this Court, both the parties i.e. petitioner and respondent No.2-complainant are present in the Court, today and are identified by their respective counsel.

In view of the statement of the complainant-Prabhjot Kaur recorded separately, and considering the affidavit furnished by the petitioner and the complainant, the present petition is allowed and the FIR No.271, dated 11.11.2014, under Section 354 and 506, IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar is quashed.

Vide order dated 12.02.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner was directed to deposit a sum of Rs.50,000/- with the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court subject to final order to be passed in this case. Accordingly, the amount deposited by the petitioner be released in favour of respondent No.2- Prabhjot Kaur (complainant).
