This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from accused persons in case bearing FIR No. 172 dated 20.11.2014, registered at Police Station Phase 8, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner is a practicing Advocate in this High Court and a member of the Bar Association. He has further argued that a murderous attack was made on the petitioner and his family and in this context a letter/representation(Annexure P-2) was also sent through the Honorary Secretary of the Bar Association to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali - respondent No.3 but no action has been taken thereon and that he would be satisfied if a direction

is issued to the said respondent to decide the said letter/representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, Punjab to look into the matter/ representation(Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and take whatever action he deems necessary.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
