**JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.185 dated 05.05.2010, under Sections 354 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh, along with all subsequent proceedings arising from that FIR, on the basis of compromise.

Report of learned trial Court has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have been entered into compromise without any pressure and undue influence. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

It is pretty settled that compromise is the soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

In view of the above circumstances, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.185

dated 05.05.2010, under Sections 354 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
