Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, in a case arising out of FIR No.229 dated 01.11.2014, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala.

The recovery of 8140 intoxicated capsules has been affected from one Rakesh @ Sahil @ Chuha and in his disclosure statement he named the present petitioner that the capsules were purchased from the present petitioner.

Counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh has informed this Court that the petitioner is working in a karyana shop with his father where he sells intoxicated capsules and he has supplied the same to the co-accused and he has not given any other information from

where he got the capsules in his karyana shop.

The petitioner is in custody since 04.11.2014 and the challan has not yet been presented and the FSL report is still awaited.

Keeping in view that the present petitioner is not arrested from the spot and the recovery was not made from his possession, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.
