The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.1 dated
01.01.2013, registered under Sections 21, 22, 21(61) of the Narcotic
Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, (for short, 'the NDPS Act') at
P.S. Mehta, Amritsar Rural, Distt. Amritsar.

Heard.

As per the reply filed by the learned State counsel, the petitioner is a known case of HCV +ve infection and requires to be treated by administering weekly interferon injections. The required injections and treatment is not available with the local hospital and the petitioner has been referred to the PGIMER, Chandigarh.

The petitioner is suffering from Hepatitis C, the treatment of which is not available in the jail. He is a young man of 20 years.

In the circumstances, the petitioner is allowed interim bail for a period of six months for availing the treatment from PGIMER, Chandigarh, on furnishing of adequate bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall surrender back before the jail authorities on the date to be noticed by the releasing Court.
