The present petition has been filed by petitioner Sunny Malhotra for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 258 dated 23.12.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station E-Division, District Amritsar.

As per prosecution allegations the present petitioner has extorted the co-accused and has given a baseball bat blow on the right wrist of the complainant Naveen Anand and that injury is simple in nature.

Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Narayan Singh, Police Station E-Division, Amritsar has stated that the petitioner

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has already joined the investigation and even the weapon of offence has been recovered from his possession. He is no longer required for any custodial interrogation.

As the injury attributed to the present petitioner is simple in nature. The petitioner has already joined the investigation and even the recovery of weapon of offence has been effected from him. So, he is no longer required for any custodial interrogation.

Thus, the order of interim anticipatory bail is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
