Quashing of FIR has been prayed for on the basis of
Compromise.

The petitioners had earlier filed a petition for quashing of FIR
on the basis of compromise. The compromise was admitted, however,
certain terms of the compromise having not been complied with by the
petitioners. The petition was disposed of on October 1, 2015.

Counsel for the petitioners has informed that the challan has not
yet been presented and that the terms of the compromised entered into
between the petitioners and the complainant have now been finally satisfied.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jashanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Copy given.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the investigating officer shall record the statements of the complainant, if voluntarily rendered, or any other effected party. On the basis of the said supplementary statements if the investigating officer is of the opinion that cancellation or untraced report deserves to be filed, the same may be filed. In case on presentation of said report it will be open to the complainant or the effected parties to appear and furnish no objection on which the Illaqa Magistrate would accept the report subject to the circumstances at that time.
