1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.207 dated 25.05.2015 registered under Sections 307/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54 of the Arms Act (Section 302 IPC added later on) at Police Station A-Division, Amrtisar.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that similarly situated co-accused was granted concession of bail by order dated 07.12.2015.

Learned Additional Advocate General, on instructions from Investigating Officer has accepted this fact.

In my opinion there is no distinction between these two cases. In these circumstances without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner. Let him be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
