SURYA KANT, J. (ORAL)

1.) The petitioner is involved in multiple cases registered under the NDPS Act. In some of the cases, he has been acquitted. His prayer to release him on regular bail has been declined by the Special Judge as well as this Court vide order dated 18.12.2015 passed in CRM-M-6530 of 2015.

2.) In this second petition, the petitioner seeks interim bail for a period of four weeks to enable him to look after his mother who is stated to be hospitalized in Christian Medical College, Ludhiana and also to get his wife treated who too is allegedly suffering from

multiple ailments.

3.) Since full particulars whether there is any other brother and sister of the petitioner who can look after his ailing mother and the details of hospitalization, if any, required for his wife etc. are not fully disclosed, we decline to entertain this petition and relegate the petitioner to approach the learned Special Court for grant of interim bail. Needless to say that if the said Court, after obtaining a fact finding report through the prosecution, is satisfied with the cause of interim bail pleaded by the petitioner, his prayer shall be sympathetically considered, uninfluenced of the previous orders.

4.) Disposed of with liberty aforesaid.
