In the present petition, the petitioner seeks direction to the trial court for expeditious disposal of case in FIR No.199, dated 23.06.2006, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

As per averments made in para No.6 of the petition, the statements of the accused under Section 313 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 were recorded on 13.01.2015 and the case is now fixed for final arguments on 11.02.2015, which is yet to arrive.

Since, the case is fixed for final arguments, therefore, there is no need for further direction to the trial court.

It is expected that the trial court shall not further delay the matter.

The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
