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**HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)**

Through the instant petition, petitioner has sought direction to the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, as they have married against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. It is further submitted that respondents No. 4 and 5 are not accepting their marriage and are resorting to illegal means. It is further submitted that in view of the imminent danger to their life and liberty, petitioners have moved a representation dated 05.12.2014 (Annexure P-3) before Superintendent of Police, Mewat at Nuh.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have got married but without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take necessary action on representation dated 05.12.2014 (Annexure P-3), as warranted by law.

In the meantime, necessary order shall be passed to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.
