Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.170 dated 13.11.2014, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC and Section 10 of the Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Dasuya, Hoshiarpur at the instance of Davinder Pal Kaur alleging that she has been duped by her brother-in-law (jija), nephew sister's son and the sister by receiving money with a promise that her son Lovepreet will be sent abroad by her nephew.

Parties have entered into a compromise. Copy of the compromise has been placed on record. Challan has not been presented.

Jasbir Kaur, named in the FIR has not filed the petition.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that investigating officer will record the supplementary statement of the complainant within a

period of 15 days and would finally decide the further course of action.

It will be open to the investigating agency to present cancellation report. In case the cancellation report is submitted, it will be open to the complainant to opt not to file any protest petition.

In view of said eventuality, the cancellation report will be accepted by the trial Court.

Disposed of expecting that the needful will be done within a total period of three months.
