This is an application for placing on record the copy of representation dated 18.11.2015 as Annexure P-9.

Criminal Misc. Application is allowed and Annexure P-9 is taken on record.

***Crl. Misc. No.M-42144 of 2015***

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is being harassed by the local police as certain complaints of corruption were made by him against the police officials. The petitioner was earlier implicated in a case under the Gambling Act and in that case, he is on bail. There is no other case or complaint pending against him. The father of the petitioner had also filed ***Criminal Writ Petition No.1628 of 2015***, wherein, notice of motion has been issued and is now fixed for hearing on 26.02.2016. The father and brother of the petitioner had also filed ***Criminal Misc. No.M-38193 of 2015*** and ***Criminal Misc. No.M-40114 of 2015*** for issuance of advance notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C and the aforesaid

petitions were disposed of vide orders dated 06.11.2015 and 28.11.2015 with a direction that in case, the complaint is pending or registered against the petitioner and the presence of the petitioner is required, an advance notice of one week be given to him.

Heard the arguments of learned counsel for the petitioner and have also perused the documents available on the file.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case, any complaint or case is pending or registered against the petitioner, where, his presence is required, then an advance notice of one week be given to him under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
