The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.),' has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.149 dated 28.10.2014, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Dehlon, Distt. Ludhiana City.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not even present in India at the time of the alleged occurrence. She has been roped only on the ground that she is married to Ramanjit @ Ramandeep Singh, co-accused.

The learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order passed by this Court on 11.12.2014.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 11.12.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
