ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.35 dated 24.01.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 472, 506, 34, 120-B IPC, Police Station Gharaunda, District Karnal.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner while giving the background of the case urges that the petitioner in fact is a victim of circumstances and a false case had been registered as he was

unable to honour the agreement on account of the stay order and the petitioner is in custody since 04.10.2015 and no recovery is to be effected.

The complainant side had appeared and has opposed the application. It is stated that earlier co-accused Jagan Nath had approached this Court seeking anticipatory bail which had been dismissed on 25.08.2015. It is also stated that the petitioner is related to Jagan Nath.

The State counsel informs that investigations are going on and three accused are yet to be arrested who are on the run and the bail application filed by Jagan Nath had been dismissed. It was also stated that P.O. proceedings have been initiated against three of the accused.

The allegations in the present case are that he was hand in glove with Naresh and a story has been weaved and money had been obtained and there was a common intention and documents had been created with the whole purpose of cheating the complainant. The entire consideration involved is over Rs.1 crore which had been received 4 years ago. The police is still investigating the case. The accused are on the run. No case for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
