In compliance of the order of this Court dated 14.12.2015, affidavit of Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Patiala, filed in Court today, is taken on record.

As per the affidavit, respondent No.2-Manjit Singh S/o Sh. Harnek Singh, in compliance with order of the State Transport Appellate Tribunal, Punjab (hereinafter referred to as the 'Tribunal') dated 27.09.1999 was issued one mini bus permit with four return trips daily on Ludhiana-Dehlon via Model Town, dugri, Dhandra, Kheri, Hamayunpur, Jassowal, Alamgir, Kaind, route for a period of five years. This permit was valid up to 27.04.2005.

It is further stated that after expiry of the permit on 27.04.2005, respondent No.2-Manjit Singh did not make an application for the grant of renewal of the permit and also failed to avail the opportunity of personal hearing afforded to him by the office of the Secretary Regional Transport Authority, Patiala, in its meeting held on 21.04.2006.

In view of the above, the permit in question so granted to respondent No.2-Manjit Singh was refused and such refusal which gave him a fresh cause of action was never challenged by him.

In view of the aforesaid facts, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
